FIGURE 1: Nutrition-Relevant Allocations in USD 2014




FIGURE 2: Nutrition Specific and Nutrition Sensitive Allocations in USD 2014




FIGURE 3: Allocations Across Sectors in USD 2014




FIGURE 4: Sources of Financing in USD 2014




FIGURE 5: Typology of Interventions Within the Health Sector





FIGURE 6: Typology of Interventions Within the Agriculture Sector

Explanatory note:

Vietnam's budgetary structure is aggregated at the level of program implementation where each budget line item represents a nutrition-related program. With this information, the 2015 analysis by Vietnam identifies 14 nutrition relevant programs managed by two identified MDA's and two non-governmental organizations in 2014 which totaled \$0.32 per-capita (all estimates in USD). When weighted estimates are applied the budget allocation share for nutrition drops to \$0.35 per-capita.

Figure 1 highlights the budgetary allocations across the two identified MDA's. Relying on Upper-bound measurements, the Ministry of Agriculture allocates \$0.00 per-capita (weighted per-capita \$0.00) for 1 program, and the Ministry of Health allocates \$0.32 per-capita (weighted per-capita \$0.12) for 9 nutrition-related programs. Figure 1 also groups two non-governmental organizations as "other", where upper-bound measurements identify that UNICEF allocates \$0.17 per-capita (weighted per-capita \$0.17) on 1 nutrition related program while World Vision allocates \$0.07 per-capita (weighted per-capita \$0.05) across 3 nutrition-related programs.

Figure 2 explains that 8 nutrition-sensitive programs totaled \$0.28 per-capita (weighted per-capita \$0.07) in allocations while 6 nutrition-specific projects accounted for \$0.28 per-capita (weighted per-capita \$0.28). The Ministry of Agriculture and two non-governmental organizations implement nutrition-sensitive programs, and the Ministry of Health and two non-governmental organizations implement nutrition-specific projects.

Figure 3 highlights nutrition related budgetary allocations across 4 sectors: Agriculture, Social Protection, Health and Education.

Two MDA's manage 2 programs in the Agriculture sector: the Ministry of Agriculture, and World Vision. Upper-bound estimates suggest that 3.5% of the total related budget or \$0.02 per-capita is allocated to this sector (weighted per-capita \$0.01).

One non-governmental organization oversees 1 program related to the Education sector: World Vision. Upper-bound measurements suggest that 5% or \$0.03 per-capita is allocated to this sector (weighted per-capita \$0.03).

Two MDA's implement 10 programs related to the Health sector: the Ministry of Health (11 programs) and UNICEF (1 project). Upper-bound estimates identify that 60% of the budget or \$0.34 per-capita is allocated to this sector (weighted per-capita \$0.15).

One non-governmental organization implements 1 program related to the Social Protection Sector: UNICEF. Upper-bound figures highlight that 30% of the nutrition related budget or \$0.17 per-capita is allocated to this sector (weighted per-capita \$0.17).

Figure 4 outlines the upper-bound sources of financing across nutrition sensitive and specific programs. Domestic sources of financing allocate \$0.26 per-capita for 7 nutrition-sensitive programs and \$0.06 per-capita for 3 nutrition-specific programs. External funds allocate \$0.02 per-capita for 1 nutrition-sensitive program and \$0.22 per-capita for 3 nutrition-specific projects.

Figure 5 outlines the typology of 7 types of interventions related to the Health sector: Immunization (1 program), Reproductive Health (3 programs), uncategorized (3 programs), Infectious Diseases (1 program), Nutrition (1 program), Food Safety (1 program), and Overweight, Obesity and NCD (1 program). Upper-bound estimates suggest that these 11 budget-line items total \$0.34 per-capita in allocations (\$0.35 per-capita with weighted estimates).

Figure 6 details the typology of 2 types of interventions related to the Agriculture sector: Agriculture Production Non-Staples (1 program), and Food Security (1 program). Upper-bound estimates suggest that these 2 budget-line items total \$0.02 per-capita in allocations (\$0.01 per-capita with weighted estimates).

Figure 7 highlights the typology of 1 type of intervention related to the Social Protection and Education sectors: Social Protection of Children (1 program), and H&N Education (1 program), respectively. Upper-bound estimates suggest that these 2 budget-line items total \$0.20 per-capita in allocations (\$0.20 per-capita with weighted estimates).
