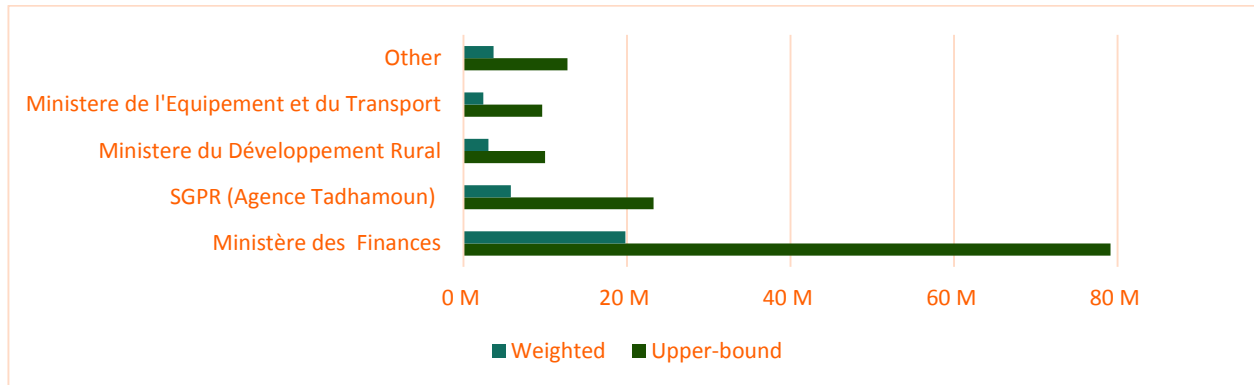
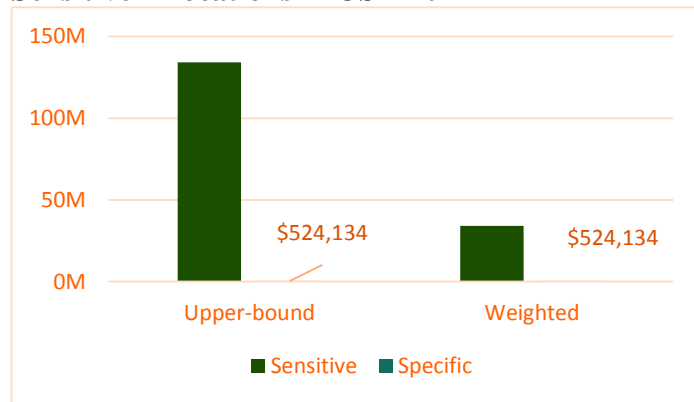

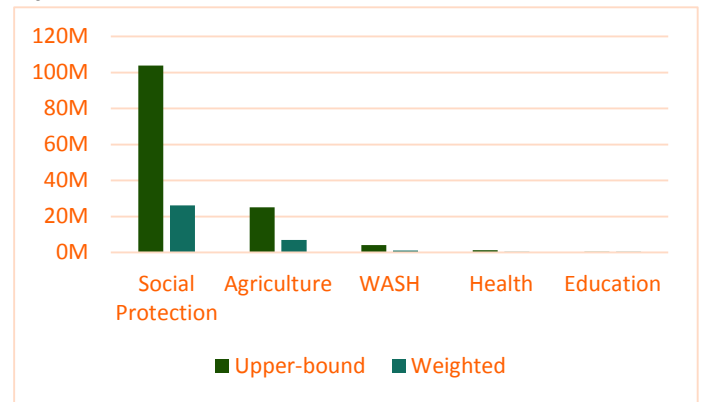
**FIGURE 1: Nutrition-Relevant Allocations in USD 2014**



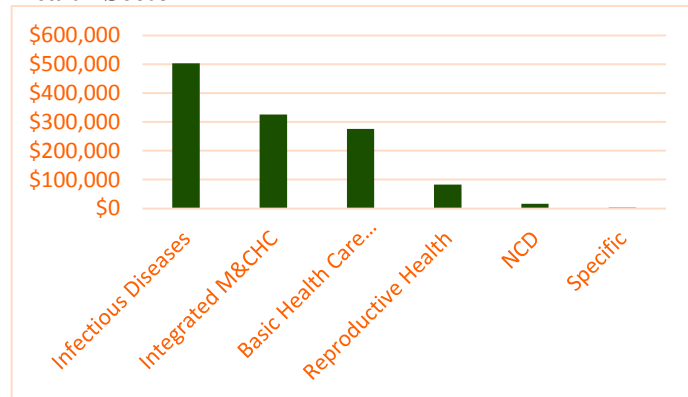
**FIGURE 2: Nutrition Specific and Nutrition Sensitive Allocations in USD 2014**



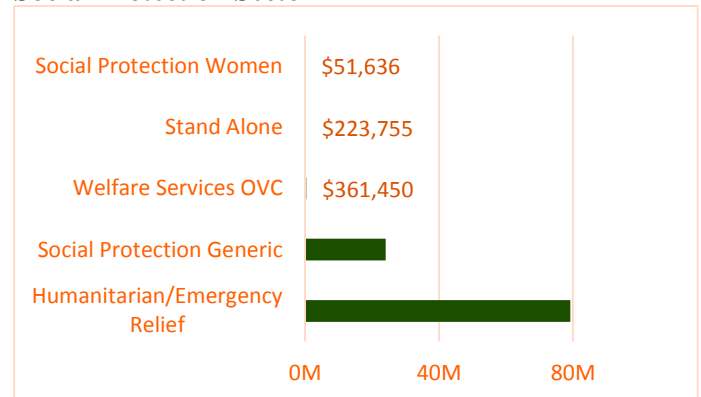
**FIGURE 3: Allocations Across Sectors in USD 2014**



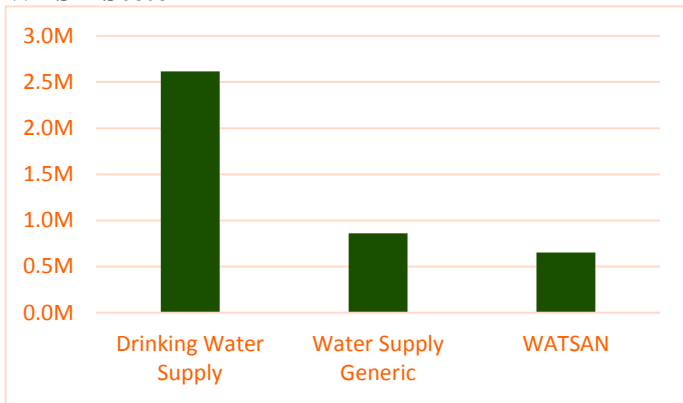
**FIGURE 4: Typology of Interventions Within the Health Sector**



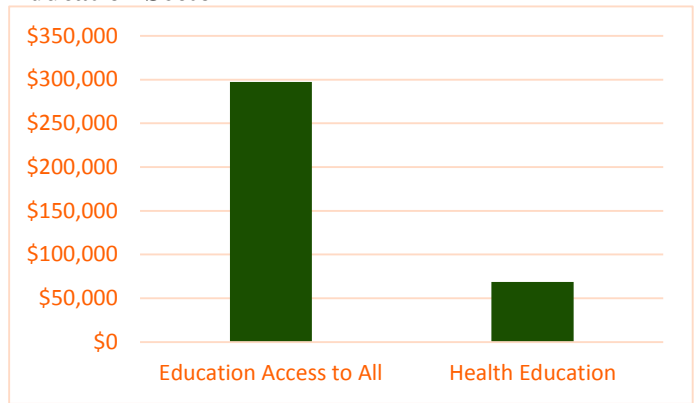
**FIGURE 5: Typology of Interventions Within the Social Protection Sector**



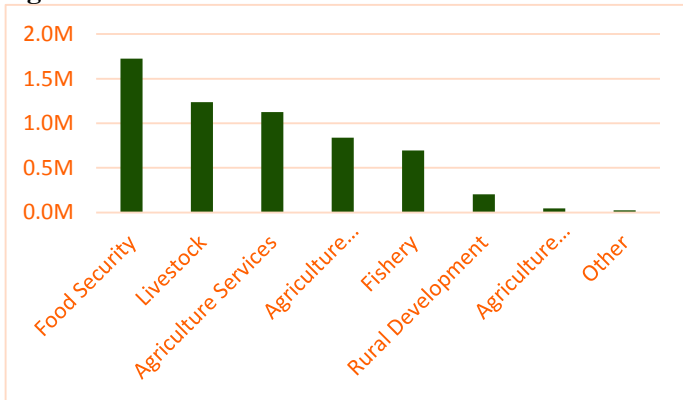
**FIGURE 6: Typology of Interventions Within the WASH Sector**

**Explanatory note:**

Mauritania's budgetary structure is aggregated at the program level. This means that each budget line item represents a program. With this information, the 2015 analysis by Mauritania identifies 53 nutrition-related programs managed by seven identified MDA's in 2014 which totaled \$19.12 per-capita (all estimates in USD). When weighted estimates are applied the budget allocation share for nutrition drops to \$8.64 per-capita.

**Figure 1** highlights the nutrition spending allocations of the seven MDA's. Upper-bound estimates identify that the Ministère de l'Hydraulique et de l'Assainissement allocates \$8.77 per-capita and manages 7 programs. The Agence Tadamoun allocates \$6.05 per-capita and implements 2 programs. The Ministère du Développement Rural allocates \$2.50 per-capita and manages 19 programs. The remaining four MDA's grouped as other in Figure 1 collectively allocate \$1.80 per-capita and manage 25 programs.

**Figure 2** identifies that \$0.06 per-capita is allocated to 3 nutrition-specific programs, and \$19.06 per-capita is allocated to 50 nutrition-sensitive programs. Two MDA's implement nutrition-specific programs while seven MDA's manage nutrition-sensitive programs.

**Figure 3** outlines the nutrition related allocations by the nine relevant MDA's across four sectors: Agriculture, Health, Social Protection and Wash.

Two MDA's manage 26 programs related to the Agriculture sector: Commissariat à la Sécurité Alimentaire (4 programs), and Ministère du Développement Rural (19 programs). Upper-bound estimates identify that 18% of the nutrition-related budget or \$6.31 per-capita is allocated to this sector.

One MDA manages 2 programs related to the Education sector: Ministère de l'Éducation Nationale. Upper-bound estimates identify that 0.004% of the budget or \$0.09 per-capita is allocated to this sector.

One MDA manages 11 programs related to the Health sector: Ministère de la Santé. Upper-bound estimates identify that 1% of the budget or \$0.30 per-capita is allocated to this sector.

Two MDA's manage 9 programs related to the Social Protection sector: Agence Tadamoun (2 programs), and Ministère des Affaires Sociales de l'Enfant et de la Famille (5 programs). Upper-bound estimates suggest that 77% of the nutrition-related budget or \$26.08 per-capita is allocated to this sector.

One MDA manages 8 programs related to the WASH sector: Ministère de l'Hydraulique et de l'Assainissement. Upper-bound estimates suggest that 3% or \$1.04 per-capita is allocated to this sector.

**Figure 4** outlines the typology of 6 types of interventions related to the Health sector: Infectious Diseases (4 programs), Integrated M&CHC (2 programs), Basic Health Care Generic (1 program), Reproductive Health (2 programs), NCD (1 program), and Specific (1 program). Upper-bound estimates suggest that these 11 budget-line items total \$0.30 per-capita in allocations.

**Figure 5** highlights the typology of 4 types of intervention related to the Social Protection sector: Humanitarian/ Emergency Relief (2 programs), Social Protection Generic (2 programs), Welfare Services OVC (2 programs), Stand Alone (2 programs), and Social Protection Women (1 program). Upper-bound estimates suggest that these 9 budget-line items total \$26.08 per-capita in allocations.

**Figure 6** outlines the typology of 3 types of interventions related to the WASH sector: Drinking Water Supply (3 programs), Water Supply Generic (1 program), and WATSAN (4 programs). Upper-bound estimates suggest that these 8 budget-line items total \$1.04 per-capita in allocations.

**Figure 7** outlines the typology of 2 types of interventions related to the Education sector: Education Access to All (1 program), and Health Education (1 program). Upper-bound estimates suggest that this 1 budget-line items total \$0.09 per-capita in allocations.

**Figure 8** identifies the typology of 5 types of interventions related to the Agriculture sector: Agriculture Production Development (12 programs), Food Security (8 programs), Livestock (4 programs), Food Safety (1 program), and Rural Development (1 program). Upper-bound estimates suggest that these 26 budget-line items total \$6.31 per-capita in allocations.
