

NUTRITION INVESTMENT SNAPSHOT: BENIN



SUMMARY TABLE

Benin's budgetary structure is aggregated at the programme level. This means that each budget line item represents a programme. With this information, the 2016 analysis identifies 63 nutrition-relevant programmes, of which 48 programmes received allocations in 2015. The 48 nutrition-relevant programmes are overseen by twelve ministries, departments and agencies (MDAs), which allocated 11.50 per capita in 2015 (all estimates are in USD).

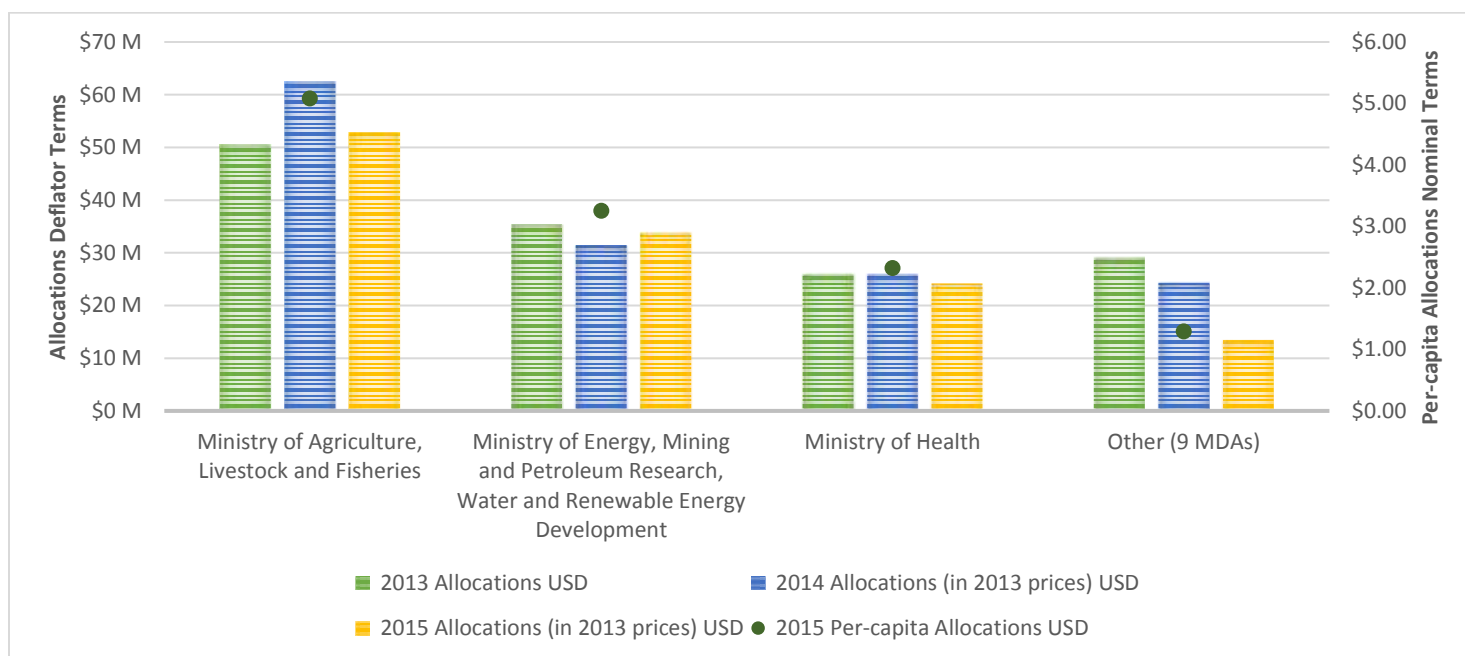
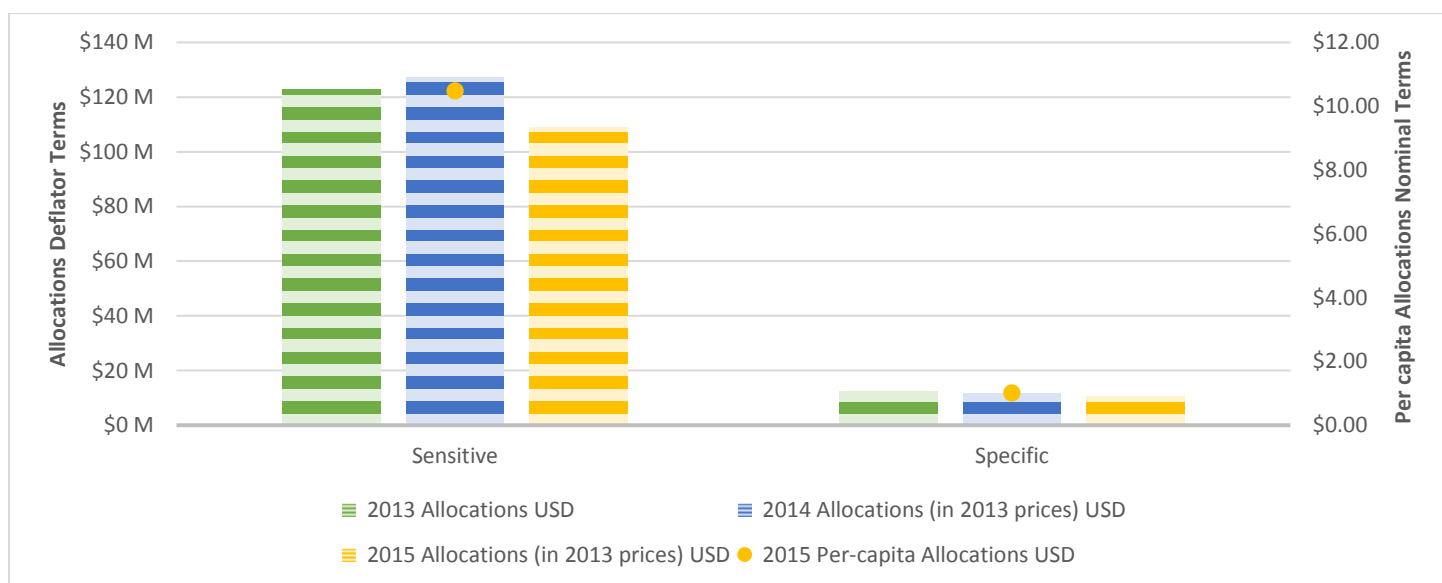

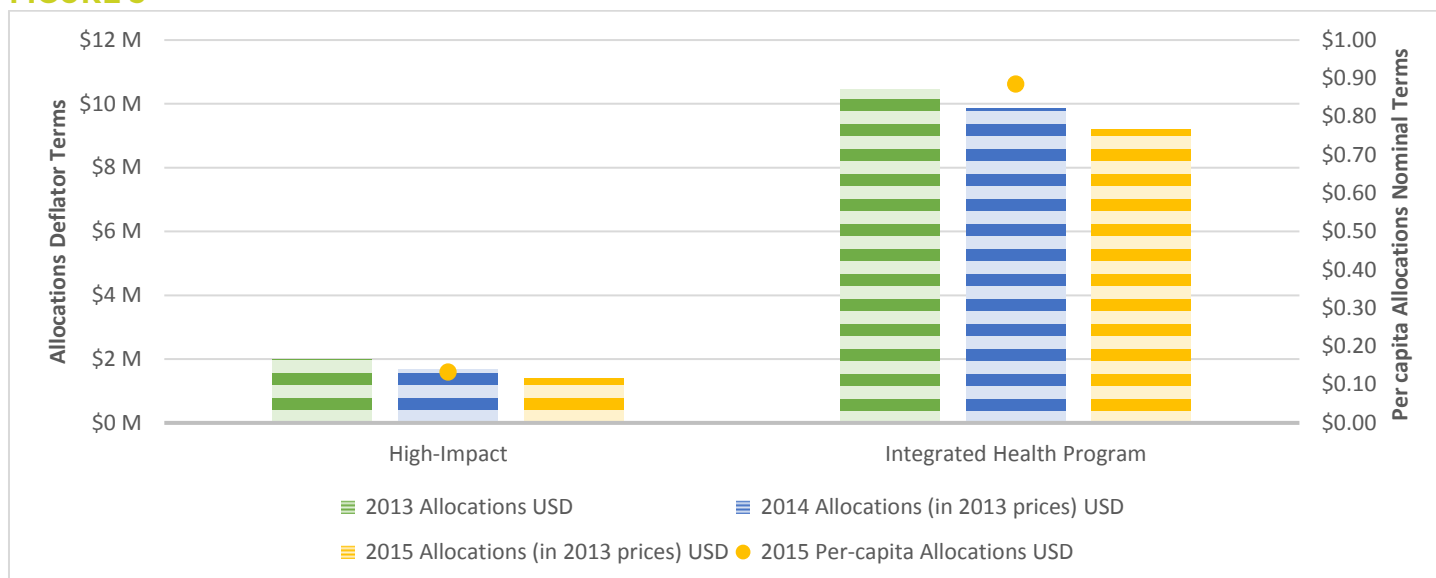

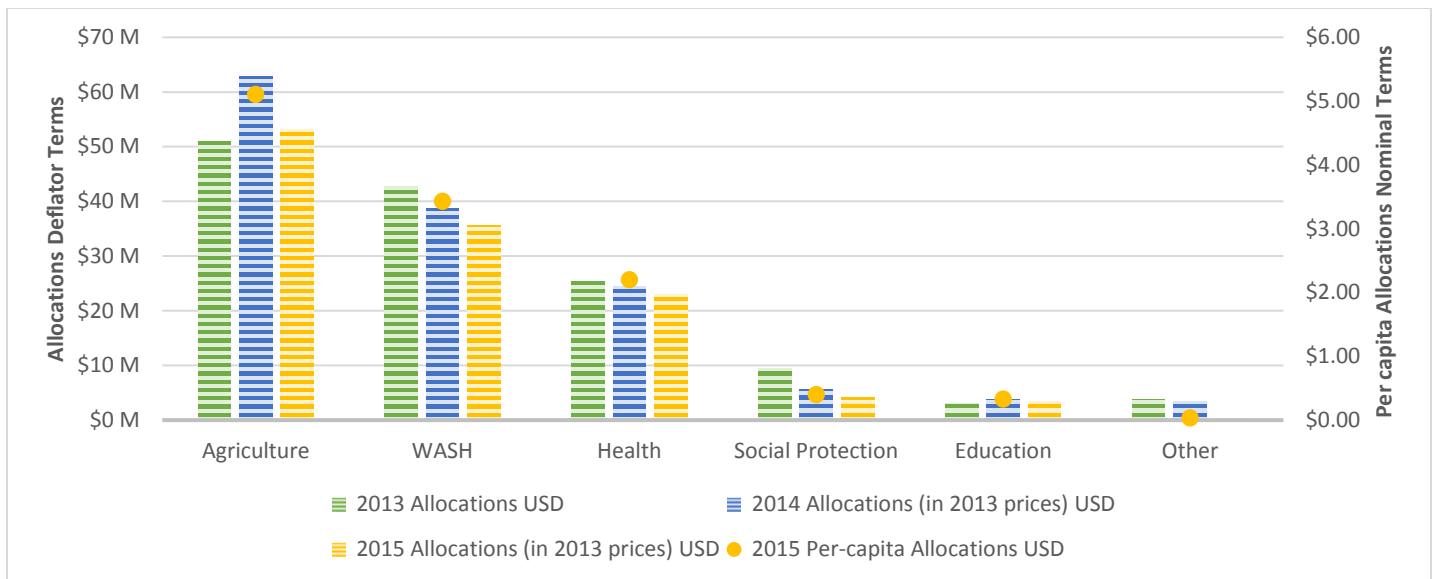

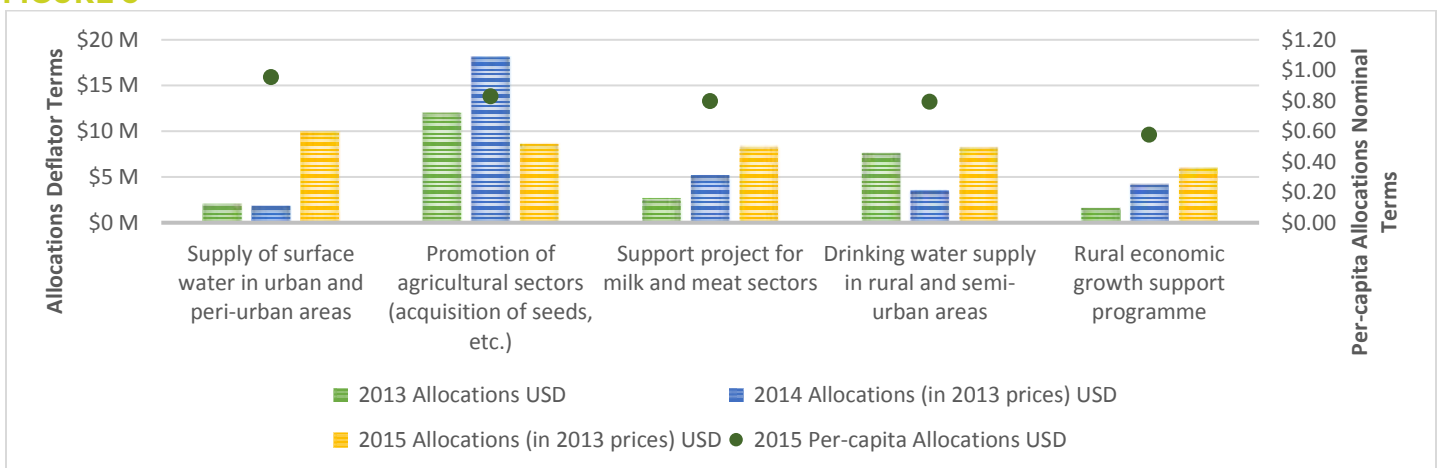
