

# NUTRITION INVESTMENT SNAPSHOT: EL SALVADOR



59 ministries are leading a global movement to end malnutrition in all its forms.

## SUMMARY TABLE

El Salvador's budgetary structure is aggregated at the sub-activity level. This means that each budget line item represents a sub-activity of a programme. With this information, the 2016 analysis identifies 59 sub-activities of 16 nutrition-relevant programmes. The 59 nutrition-relevant sub-activities are overseen by eighteen ministries, departments and agencies, which allocated 22.77 per capita in 2015 (all estimates in USD with applied weighting).

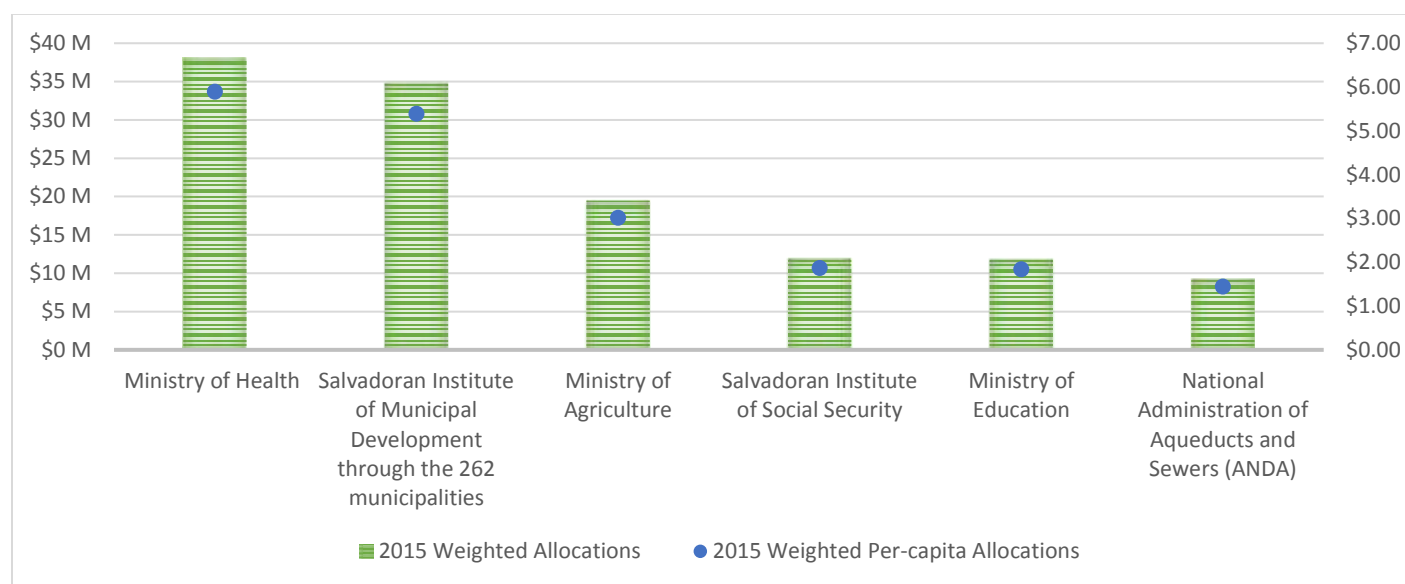

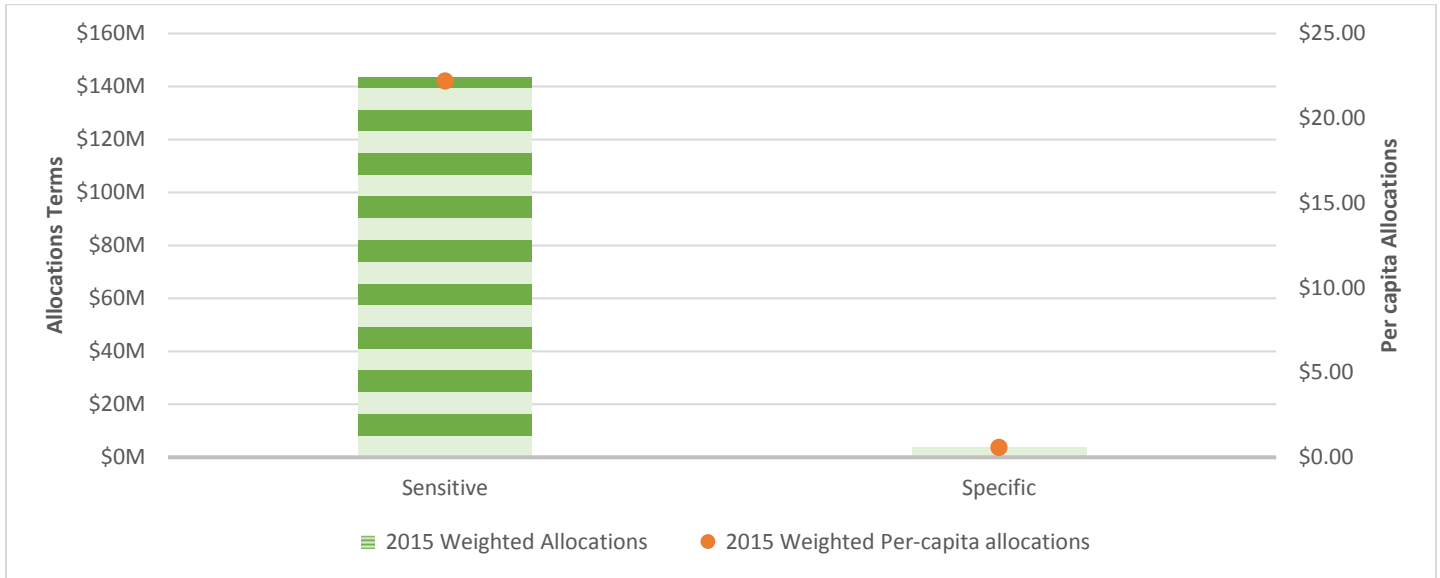

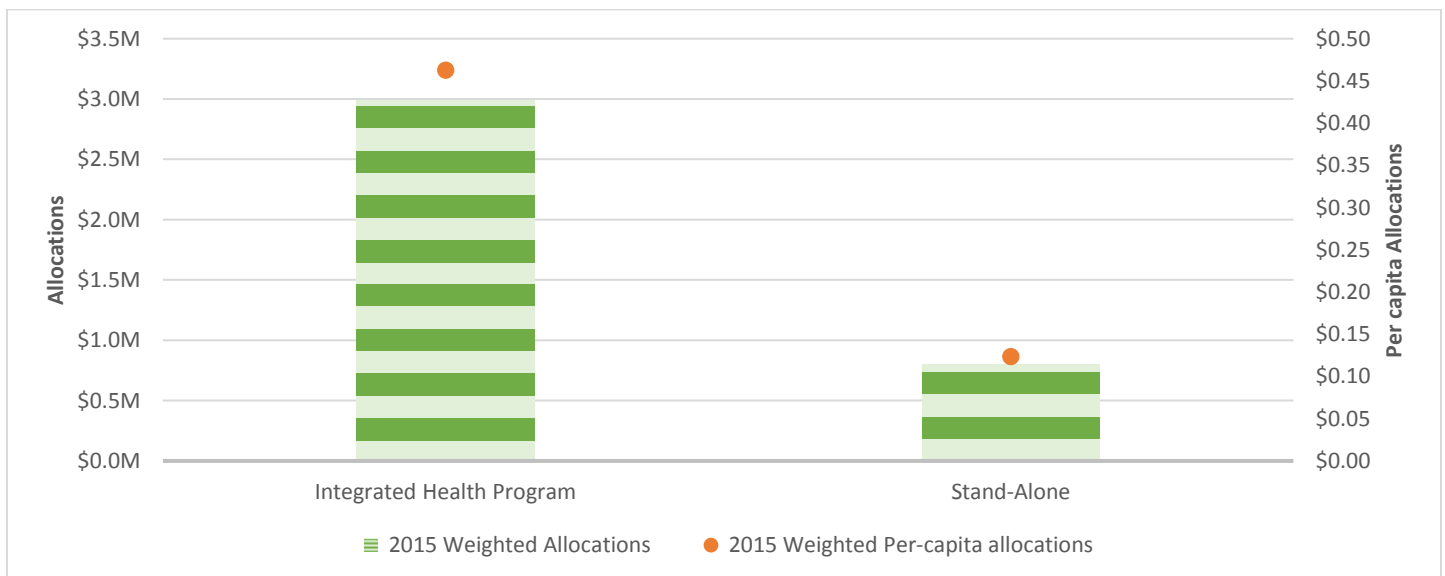

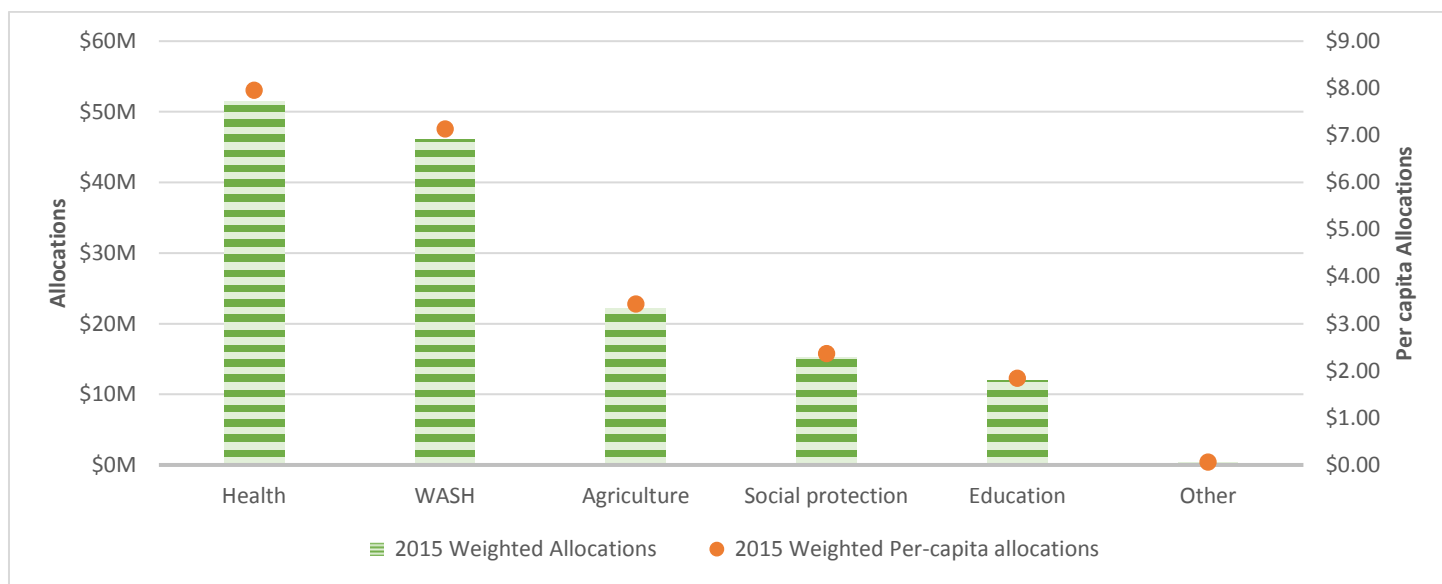

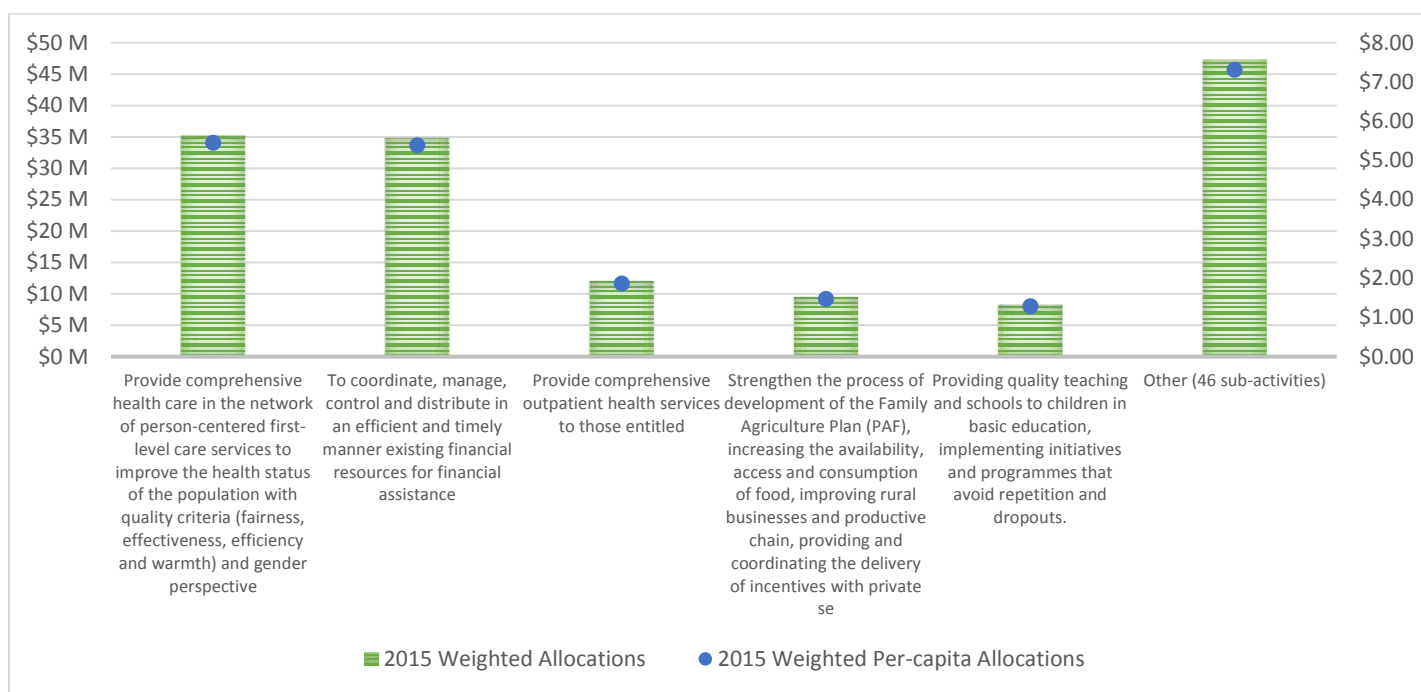
