

NUTRITION INVESTMENT SNAPSHOT: MAURITANIA



59 ministries are leading a global movement to end malnutrition in all its forms.

SUMMARY TABLE

Mauritania's budgetary structure is aggregated at the programme level. This means that each budget line item represents a programme. With this information, the 2016 analysis identifies 83 nutrition-relevant programmes, of which 56 programmes received allocations in 2015. The 56 nutrition-relevant programmes are overseen by sixteen ministries, departments and agencies (MDAs), which allocated 11.24 per capita in 2015 (all estimates in USD).

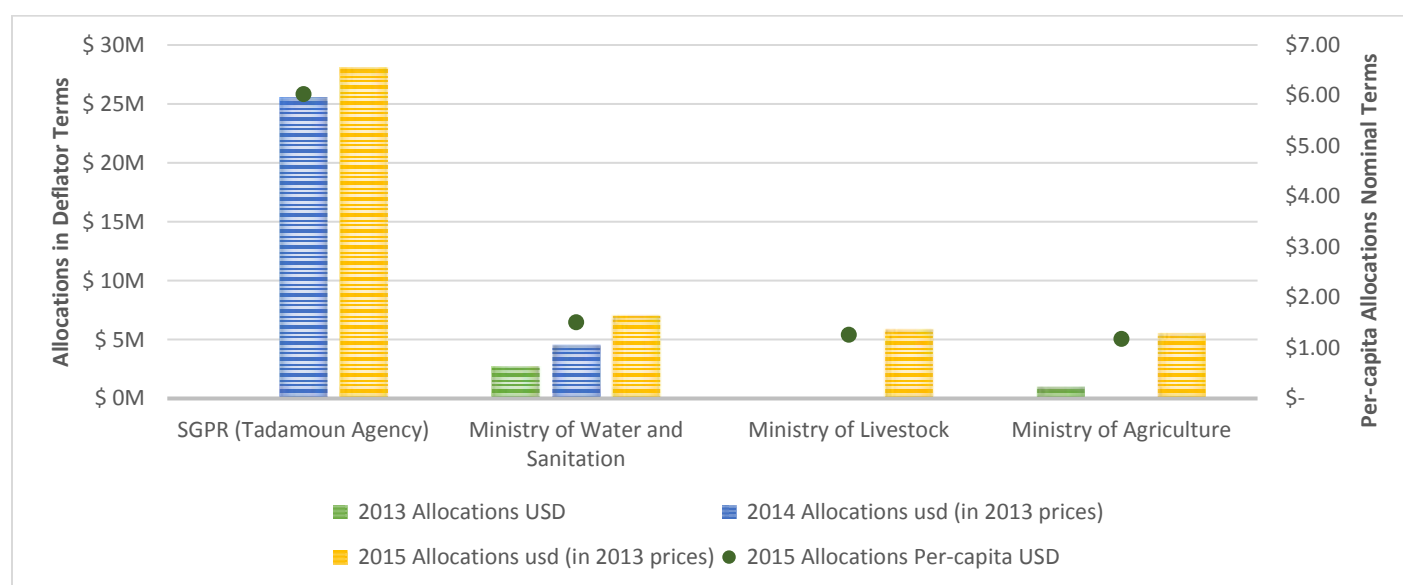

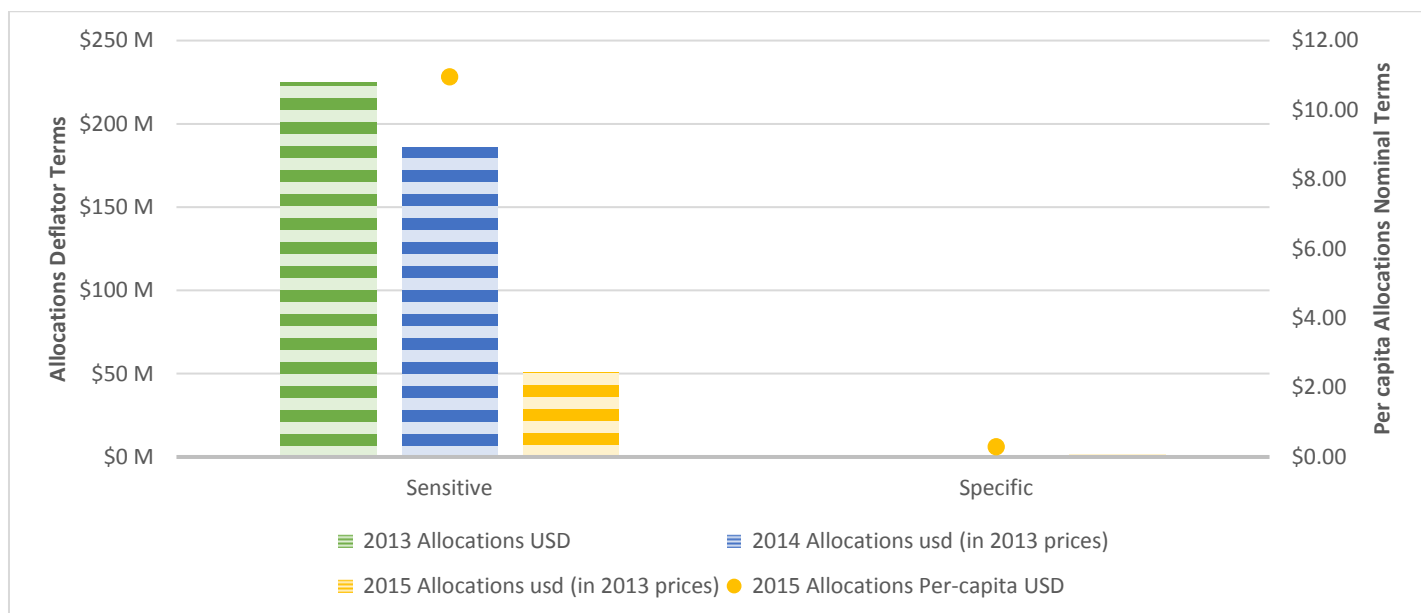

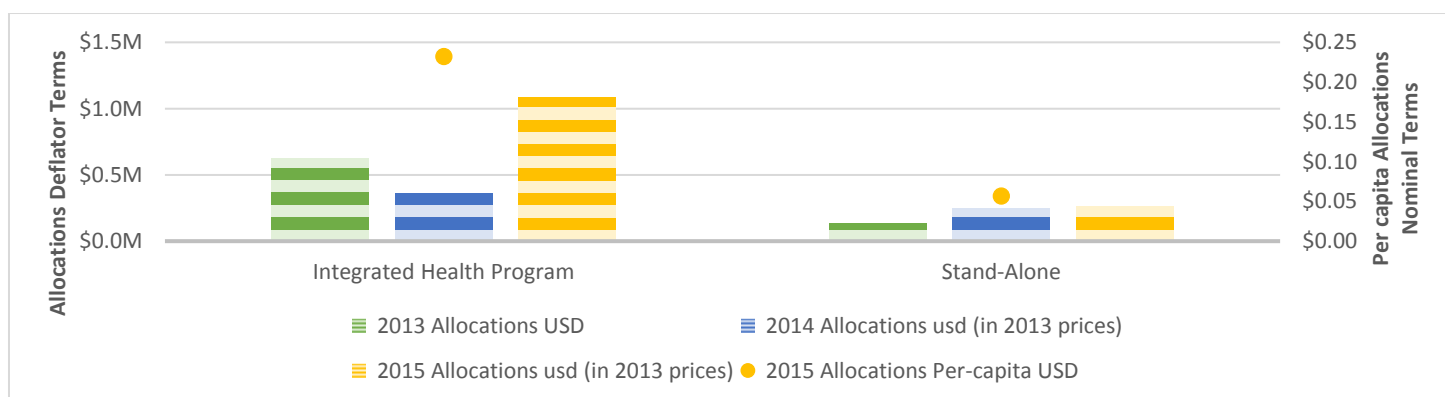

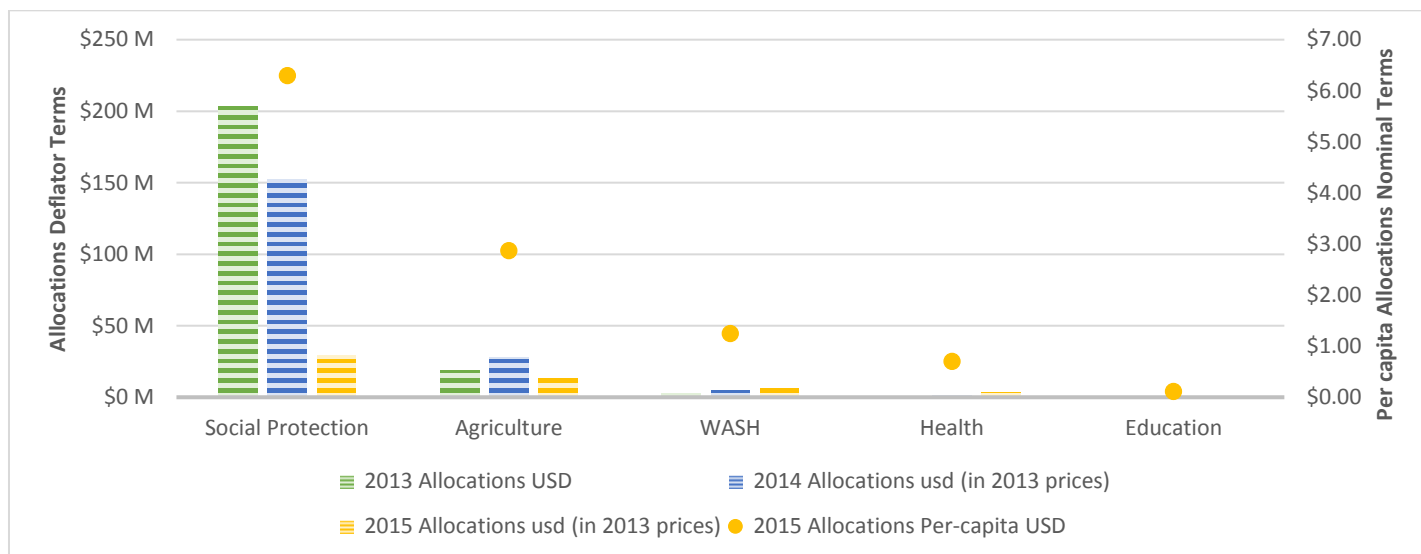

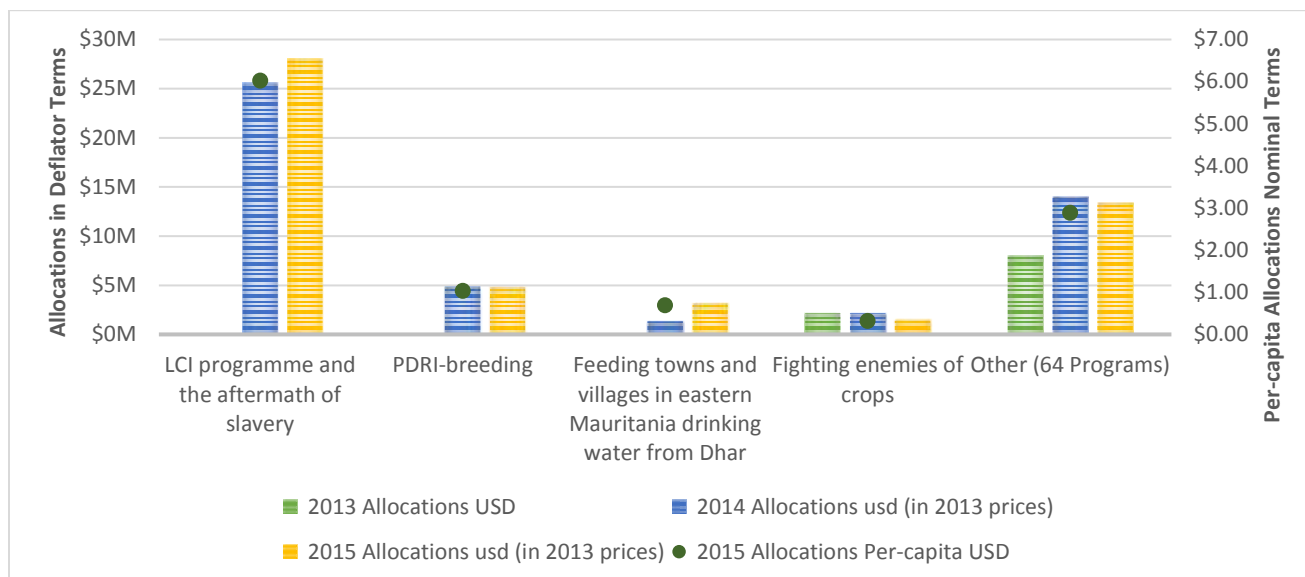
