The National Strategy for Early Childhood Development is an important step to expand access and quality to preschool and other essential early childhood development services. Data availability on ECD access and outcomes is limited. A few pieces of administrative data for Yemen are available; these figures reflect total uptake of services and are gathered through a census.
